



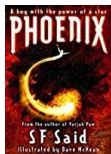

English

Science Fiction Stories (Phoenix) - The children will be looking at the genre of Science fiction before they try to produce their own Science Fiction short story for a specific audience.

We will then be looking at information booklets and producing an information booklet of our own.



Geography

Rainforests and vegetation belts.



We will be learning about the five different vegetation belts, locating the world's major rainforests on a map and learning all about why they are so amazing.

Computing



We are cryptographers - pupils will investigate early methods of communicating over distances, learn about two early ciphers, and encrypt and decrypt messages in various ciphers.

Music



Make You Feel My Love by Bob Dylan – a Pop Ballad sung by Adele.

As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other pop ballads.

Maths

Fractions- add, subtract, order and find equivalent fractions.

Multiplication – multiplying a 4 digit number by a 2 digit number, short division, dividing a 4 digit number by a 1 digit number and solving problems with multiplication and division.

We will be completing our board work challenges daily, which will look at patterns within number and revisiting learning.

Detail and layers using mixed media – we will look at the artwork of Henri Rousseau. We will then use different mediums to produce his style of work
